



Adolescent Workshop Towards the New Adult: Embracing the Whole Adolescent

Thursday, 5 June 2008, Sydney

The adolescent workshop will focus on the integration of the third plane as a continuum bridging childhood to adulthood, culminating with the new adult at age 18. The program will be grounded in Montessori principles while exploring the necessary environmental and curricular principles of the creation of adolescent programs. Focus will be given to extensions in high school from middle school, the evolution of the complete adolescent perspective including how older adolescent outcomes affect younger adolescent expectations, the mid-plane transition, and factors affecting the approach within Montessori schools as a part of the wider small school movement.



James Moudry is currently working on the creation of a Montessori High School in Cleveland, Ohio, USA. For more than eight years, James has worked in Montessori adolescent programs as a teacher, four as a program coordinator. He has taught algebra, geometry, writing, literature, philosophy, humanities, social studies, economics, and human development. James's work with adolescents, while urban-based, includes farm-based experiences, all with a focus on the adolescents' community center. James is a current faculty member of the annual NAMTA *Orientation to Adolescent Studies*. James holds the AMI 3-6 Diploma, an M.Ed. in Montessori education, and a B.A. in Philosophy, Mathematics and Psychology. James attended Montessori schools himself until age 14.
