



Level 2 First Aid Course

19 September 2008, Melbourne

The aim of this course is to develop a student's competence and confidence in providing emergency first aid. This includes calling for help, the ability to respond to first aid situations, casualty assessment, decision-making, and basic life support functions including cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). This course covers adult and child conditions.

This Nationally Recognised course is conducted in two phases.

1. Online Quiz
2. Practical Application

The online quiz takes approximately two hours to complete. You require 80% or more to pass each of the 4 modules. You can have as many attempts as necessary and you may log in and out after completing a module. This allows you to complete the quiz in your own time, however it must be finished prior to the practical day.

The practical day is a fun, no pressure day of scenarios and practical application which enables you to consolidate what you have learned online in a "hands on" manner. This is where you practice CPR on manikins and run through scenarios that may occur in everyday life. The day runs from 9.30am to 4.30pm with lunch, morning and afternoon breaks and there is plenty of discussion time for any questions you have.

You will be sent the details of how to complete the quiz on line by the 1st of September. As numbers are limited, please be advised that registrations cannot be received after the 25th August, or once the maximum number of participants has been reached.
