

In the Children's House we are always working towards total reading. We pursue this path in two parallel lines mastering not only the mechanics of word reading (phonetic reading, phonograms and puzzle words) but also exploring the function of different types of words and the meaning, emotion and style they evoke. This exploration includes phrase reading and the function of the word exercises and culminates with reading analysis and the child's ability to read and enjoy prose and poetry. A child thus equipped with total reading will delight in reading and writing, will have the capacity for research and authorship and will be ready for the full acquisition of culture available in the Montessori Primary.

Cheryl Ferreira will give an overview of total reading and revisit some of the key materials that lead the child along this path.
